Notes:

1. SDAIE courses are at grade level but taught by highly qualified teachers credentialed in SDAIE methods.
2. ELA option could be parallel reading, writing, CAHSEE course, etc.
3. Geometry may be delayed until sufficient English proficiency is demonstrated. In this case students would follow Algebra 1 with Algebra 2.
4. Enrolling an EL in Spanish II or higher raises the literacy level in primary language, thus facilitating English acquisition. Spanish I is not appropriate.
5. ELD teachers will collaborate with counselors in developing optimal student schedules.
6. All students must have a minimum of six classes in a continuous schedule.
